INTRODUCTION:

Poems, essays, and short stories are invited from Irving middle and high school students. Original works reflect experiences and unleash creativity through writing and creative thinking. Each entry must be entirely original and written directly by the student contestant, with minimal guidance from others, including teachers, parents and artificial intelligence tools.

GUIDELINES:

Poetry: Lyrical, ballad, sonnet, limerick, ode, prose.

Eligibility: **Irving and Grand Prairie middle school and high school students**

Maximum Length: Maximum 20 lines.

Entries are judged on written words, structure, clarity, and meaning.

Essays:

Eligibility: **Irving and Grand Prairie High school students**

Length: 350 words, typed double-spaced.

Criteria: Entries judged on originality, analysis, evidence, structure, and presentation.

Analysis: A thorough understanding of the subject, supported by strong arguments.

Evidence: Well-substantiated arguments using credible, integrated sources.

Structure: Logical organization, clear progression of ideas, and smooth transitions.

Presentation: Meticulously edited, formal, grammatically correct, and precisely worded academic writing.

Essay Topic:

“Civil Engagement: Political Participation, Community Action, and Advocacy and Activism”

Short Stories:

Eligibility: **Irving and Grand Prairie Middle and high school students**

Maximum Length: 350 words, typed, double-spaced.

Structure: Logical organization, clear progression of ideas, and smooth transitions.

Presentation: Meticulously edited, formal, grammatically correct, and precisely worded academic writing.

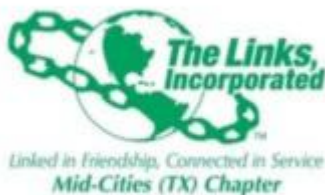
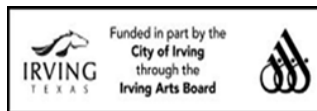
